What are XtremeRX products?

XtremeRX products contain a trifecta of hemp-derived CBD (broad spectrum), arnica & turmeric.

They can be dispensed to help alleviate many types of pain: arthritis, muscle/joint pain, neuropathy, sprains, chronic back pain, plantar fasciitis, post-surgery pain/discomfort, sciatica, fibromyalgia, carpal, tunnel, migraines, sports recovery and more.

How do XtremeRX products work?

Our products treat pain locally by interrupting pain signaling. CBD is adding a new dimension to pain care as an effective alternative to OTC and pain medication.

Are XtremeRX products Cruelty free?

Yes, Gluten free too! There's also no artificial colors, no parabens, no ethyl, no phenoxyethanol, no DEA, no ethyl alcohol. Our products are plant based and USA grown & extracted hemp.

Can I overdose on CBD?

No, CBD is very safe. There is no risk of overdosing. CBD is non-toxic and has been shown to be well-tolerated by humans, even in large doses.

What is CBD? What can CBD do for my body?

CBD is one of over 100 naturally occurring compounds, known as cannabinoids that are found in the Cannabis plant. CBD from agricultural hemp does NOT contain THC (tetrahydrocannabinol), the psychoactive "high" feeling found in marijuana. CBD functions by interacting with the body's endocannabinoid system to help control and maintain many things: pain, inflammation, memory, and the immune response.

What is the difference between hemp and marijuana?

Hemp and marijuana both belong to the Cannabis Sativa plant species. The defining characteristic between hemp and marijuana is the chemical composition contained within each plant. Both species produce CBD, the non-intoxicating cannabis compound.

The marijuana plant contains higher levels of THC. The hemp plant has less than 0.3% THC—making it an ideal source for extractions. This means you get all the beneficial properties of cannabis without any intoxicating effects.

Is CBD legal?

Yes, CBD is legal according to the 2018 Farm Bill. It is federally legal to grow, sell and consume hemp-based products, including hemp-based CBD. The same isn't true for marijuana-derived CBD products, for which legality varies by state.

Product contraindications, safety, side effects?

While topical CBD is generally well-tolerated and considered safe, edibles may cause mild side effects in some individuals, such as dry mouth, fatigue, or changes in appetite. Patients who are pregnant, breastfeeding, or have a serious medical condition should consult with their doctor before use. There are no known contraindications, but individual sensitivities should be considered.

CBD may interact with certain medications, such as blood thinners and those affecting heart rate and thyroid function, by altering their concentration. It's important for patients to discuss their CBD use with their healthcare provider, especially if they are on other medications.

Can this product be used during work hours? Will this product be tested positive for recreational drugs in drug test at a work place?

Since our products contain 0% THC, they should not yield a positive result for THC on drug tests. However, the sensitivity of drug tests can vary, and there are no guarantees. Patients should consult their employer's drug testing policies. Our products are designed to be non-intoxicating and can be used during work hours.

Can patients use this product while driving or operating heavy machinery?

Our CBD products are non-psychoactive and should not impair the ability to drive or operate machinery. However, as with any new supplement, it's recommended to use caution and understand how it affects one's body before engaging in such activities.
